

Important Notice

1. The Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education (HKAGE) can only provide services to student members aged 10 to 18 who are currently studying in schools in Hong Kong. Therefore, students should be born between 1 July 2005 to 30 September 2013 in order to apply for the "Stage 1: Screening Programme".
2. Each school can nominate up to 50 students per year for the "Screening Programme". Each nominee can enrol on ONE "Screening Programme" only.
3. Students who have successfully passed all screenings will only become HKAGE student members by June every year where Secondary 6 (or equivalent to the last year in secondary school) students will be graduating from secondary schools soon. Therefore, nominations for the "Screening Programme" from these students will not be accepted.
4. All nominations must be completed between **26 September 2022 (9:00 a.m.) to 11 October 2022 (12:00 noon)** **extended to 17 October 2022 (12:00 noon)** via the online platform. The HKAGE will not process any applications or changes to the enrolled programmes after the nomination deadline.
5. It is the applicant's responsibility to provide an **accurate and valid email addresses** for correspondence. Please contact HKAGE by email sss@hkage.org.hk **as soon as possible** if you do not receive the email of the application result and login details after the start of the "Screening Programme".
6. For each nomination, each student can apply for ONE "Screening Programme" only and multiple applications are not permitted for the same student in the same school year. Students who enrol on "Screening Programme" via "School Nomination" cannot enrol on another "Screening Programme" via "Self Nomination". The HKAGE will only consider the "School Nomination". If students wish to change the nomination channel, they must have withdrawn from the original application and apply again.
7. Schools can access the information of their students who apply via "School Nomination" or "Self Nomination" including applications and results for the "Screening Programme", progress on submission of students' personal profiles and nomination results.
8. The Screening Programmes are self-learning programmes and have no fixed timetable. Students need to study the programme and complete the final assessment within the designated period.
9. The quizzes/questions within the module of the "Screening Programme" are for students' self-assessment of the learning progress. Only the Final Assessment contributes to students' performance in the "Screening Programme". The time limit of the final assessment is 60 minutes. Students have to pass the Final Assessment to complete the "Screening Programme".
10. Students can only attempt the final assessment two times at most within the study period of the "Screening Programme". Only the higher score will be counted. The questions for the second attempt (if taken) may be different from the first one.
11. HKAGE current student members cannot apply for the "Screening Programme".
