* Contestants should remember their Contestant Number, designated venue, and must take the assigned seat. Contestants must enter the designated venue in school uniform at or before 1:30 pm and bring along their Hong Kong Identity Card AND School Student Card for identity verification. Otherwise, contestants' answer scripts may not be accepted by the HKPhO Committee. Moreover, contestants whose identity could not be verified on the spot will be required to complete a report form and have their photo taken after the contest for future verification purposes. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in their answer scripts not being marked.

* Please remember to arrive at HKUST at least 30 minutes earlier. HKUST is a large campus, and it takes a long time to travel from both the North and South gates to your exam venue.

Precautionary Measures against Communicable Diseases

- Candidates must check their body temperature before the contest.
- Candidates with fever or influenza-like illness (I.L.I.) symptoms are strongly advised to visit a doctor as soon as possible. They should not attend the contest.
- If candidates have been quarantined, they should inform the HKAGE via the Department of Health.
- At the end of the contest, candidates will be asked to follow the instructions of the venue supervisor and leave the venue row by row to prevent crowding the venue exits.
- You are highly recommended to refer to the updated guidelines at the Centre for Health Protection (CHP) website at http://www.chp.gov.hk or the Education Bureau (EDB) website http://www.edb.gov.hk/en/ towards communicable diseases and take necessary actions.

Precautionary Measures against Influenza at Contest Venue

- Candidates will be allowed to put on masks at the contest venue. Invigilators may ask these candidates to remove their masks during attendance checking when necessary.
- Candidates with sneezing or coughing should put on a mask.
- Candidates with serious sneezing or coughing may be arranged to sit at the back of the venue in order to minimize disturbance to other candidates.
