

## **Important Notice (Parent Application)**

- 1. The Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education (HKAGE) provides services exclusively to student members aged 10 to 18 currently studying in schools in Hong Kong. Therefore, students must be born between 1 July 2006 to 30 September 2014 to be eligible for applying for the "Screening Programme".
- 2. Students who successfully pass all screenings will only become HKAGE student members by June every year as Secondary 6 (or equivalent to the final year of secondary school) students will be graduating. Therefore, applications for the "Screening Programme" from these students will not be accepted.
- 3. All applications must be completed between **25 September 2023 (9:00 a.m.) to 12 October 2023 (12:00 noon)** through the online platform. The HKAGE will not process any applications or changes to the enrolled programmes after the application deadline.
- 4. It is the applicant's responsibility to provide an **accurate and valid email addresses** for correspondence. Please contact HKAGE by email <a href="mailto:sss@hkage.org.hk">sss@hkage.org.hk</a> as soon as possible if you do not receive the email of the application result and login details after the start of the "Screening Programme".
- 5. Each student can apply for ONE "Screening Programme" only and multiple applications for the same student in the same school year are not permitted. Students who enrol in the "Screening Programme" via "School Application" cannot enrol in another "Screening Programme" via "Parent Application". The HKAGE will only consider the "School Application". If students wish to change the application channel, they must withdraw from the original application and reapply.
- 6. Schools can access the information about their students who apply via "School Application" or "Parent Application" including applications and results for the "Screening Programme", progress on submission of students' personal profiles and nomination results.
- 7. The Screening Programmes are self-learning programmes with no fixed timetable. Students need to study the programme and complete the final assessment within the designated period.
- 8. The quizzes/questions within the module of the "Screening Programme" are for students' self-assessment of their learning progress. Only the Final Assessment contributes to students' performance in the "Screening Programme". The time limit for the final assessment is 60 minutes. Students must pass the Final Assessment to complete the "Screening Programme".
- 9. Students can attempt the final assessment a maximum of two times within the study period of the "Screening Programme". Only the higher score will be considered. The questions for the second attempt (if taken) may differ from the first one.
- 10. Current HKAGE student members are not eligible to apply for the "Screening Programme".
