Through activities such as self-reflection, small group discussions, participation in social enterprise workshops, and project presentations, students will acquire insights into the needs of marginalised communities and the obstacles encountered by social enterprises. Ultimately, the programme aspires to empower students to explore the societal needs present in their communities and cultivate an innovative mindset to effectively address social issues in the long term.</p> <p><b>Upon completion of the programme, the participants should be able to:</b></p> <p><b>Talk:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) define what social innovation and social entrepreneurship are.</li><li>2) cultivate awareness of pressing social issues.</li><li>3) take small steps to improve the quality of life in the local community and the world as a whole.</li><li>4) gain inspiration for career development in the field of social innovation.</li></ol> <p><b>Course Phase 1:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) explore the principles of empathy and how they relate to social innovation.</li><li>2) acquire skills in design thinking methodologies.</li><li>3) differentiate the needs of service recipients/stakeholders in social contexts.</li><li>4) develop an understanding of diverse perspectives and the challenges faced by individuals and communities.</li></ol>	



**Course Phase 2:**

- 1) develop innovative solution ideas for social challenges.
- 2) take part in market research.
- 3) measure and evaluate the social impact of their social innovation projects.
- 4) collaborate in group projects, fostering effective teamwork and cooperation.

**Course Phase 3:**

- 1) build networks, seek support, and leverage resources for their social innovation projects.
- 2) cultivate an entrepreneurial mindset to implement and sustain their social innovation projects;
- 3) effectively present project pilot results.
- 4) apply problem-solving skills in making business decisions.
