Programme Objectives The programme aims to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• enhance students' knowledge to reach the level of international excellence in science;• provide students with accelerated learning experience in science;• enhance the thinking skills, problem-solving as well as laboratory skills of students;• widen students' knowledge and raise their aspirations and confidence in competing with contestants in international competitions; and• identify the most capable students, through the 3-phase training programme, to represent HK to participate in the 22nd IJSO.	
Intended Learning Outcomes Upon completion of first two phases of the programme, the participants should be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• understand major concepts in junior science subjects, i.e. Physics, Chemistry and Biology;• solve selective scientific problems that are beyond the regular junior secondary school syllabus;• prove statements and devise solutions of IJSO past paper and upgrade their ability to answer the questions up to post- secondary level; Upon completion of phase III, the participants should be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• reach the competence to represent HK to compete in the 22nd IJSO. Upon completion of affective support sessions to be conducted by HKAGE, the participants should be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• manage their time for studying, and cope with stress in the training programme and competition;• communicate and cooperate effectively in teamwork.	
Target Participants: Awardees of First and Second Class Honours in IJSO 2025 - HK Screening are eligible to participate in Phase I training. Awardees of Third Class Honours can also join the training, and it is subject to vacancy availability and their rank order.	
Programme Hours: Phase I Training: 50 hours; Phase II Training: 56 hours; Phase III Training: 108 hours. At least 200 contact hours in total.	



Medium of Instruction: Cantonese (Supplemented with English) with English handouts.
